Niyat for Fasting (Sawm)

نَوَيْتُ أَنْ أَصُومَ غَدًا مِنْ شَهْرِ رَمَضَانَ الْبَارِكِ
فَرَضًا لَكَ يَا اللَّهُ فَتَقَبَّلْ مِنِّي إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Transliteration: Nawaitu an asuma ghadan min shahri Ramadanal Mubarak, fardal laka ya Allahu, fataqabbal minni innaka antas-samiul alim.

Meaning: "I intend to fast tomorrow in the holy month of Ramadan for your sake, O Allah. So please accept it from me. Indeed, You are the All-Hearing, All-Knowing."

Dua for Breaking the Fast (Iftar)

اللَّهُمَّ لَكَ صُمْتُ وَعَلَى رِزْقِكَ أَفْطَرْتُ بِرَحْمَتِكَ يَا أَرْحَمَ الرَّاحِمِينَ

Transliteration: Allahumma laka sumtu wa ala rizqika aftartu bi-rahmatika ya arhamar-rahimin.

Meaning: "O Allah! I fasted for You and I am breaking my fast with Your provision, by Your mercy, O Most Merciful of the merciful."
